Project Description

1. Describe the project. What was done, when, and where did project activities take place? If this is a progress report, what remains to be done?

This project provided scholarships for children who could otherwise not afford to participate in healthy, educational, and stimulating activities during the summer and fall months provided by two Homer nonprofit organizations. Twenty-one children were able to participate in supervised hiking, camping and other outdoor activities in the Kachemak Bay area, designed to increase their physical fitness, self-confidence and sense of responsibility for the environment. Another 13 students took part in a youth theatre program aimed at enhancing their self-esteem, self-confidence, and team-building ability. These events took place from August through October of this year.

2. How many people benefited from this project? 34 directly

3. Who were the beneficiaries, how were they impacted by this project, and what humanitarian need was met?

The children who received the scholarships were the immediate beneficiaries, but so were their parents and the community at large. Every community benefits when its children get the education and experience they need to become helpful, productive members of society.

1. Offered transportation to children involved in picking up litter around the community to earn credits toward scholarships.

Pier One Youth Theatre provided activities related to performing, play writing, and back-stage skills.


