ADDENDUM TO P-3261 PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Due to COVID19 safety restrictions, schools were closed during the fall semester of 2020 and the spring leadership camp was canceled. These unanticipated events were responsible for a \$16,031 surplus in the P-3261 grant at the end of the of the 2020/21 school year. At the direction of the Rotary Foundation the P-3261 surplus was carried into the 2021/22 school year to continue funding of the Everyday Leadership Project. In the 2021/22 school year, the funds will be used to offer the Everyday Leadership curriculum to <u>179 low-income 5th and 6th grade youth attending seven Titles I schools</u>. The program includes thirteen classes where the youth learn life skills such as communicating effectively, working as a team, resolving conflicts, making decisions, leading a team. They will complete of at least two community service projects, a key component in the building self- esteem among the participants. Rotary funds will be used to fund teachers, purchase supplies, and provide transportation.

In 2021, Everyday Leadership received the Leadership For Public Education Award from the Idaho Association of Public School Administrators.
