We conducted a few projects with our partners, Night Ministry and Common Pantry. In December, we donated gift-cards to the Common Pantry who was putting together holiday Bags of food and gifts for children and families. The gift card could assist in toiletry purchases since the food pantry was low on stock. In January, we held a food packing event where we made 100 meal bags for the Night Ministry for their food distribution throughout Lakeview and along the Red Line. In May, we participated in the LGBTQ+ Fellowship Food Drive and donated snack packs, the biggest need for our partner, to Night Ministry.
