Project Description

1. Describe the project. What was done, when, and where did project activities take place? If this is a progress report, what remains to be done?

The project addressed scholarships for university students. The club solicited applications from university students. Students completed the application with the understanding that the field of study addressed one of Rotary International's six areas of focus. The areas emphasized are: 1) Maternal & Child Healthcare, 2) Basic Education & Literacy, 3) Disease Prevention & Treatment, 4) Peace & Conflict Resolution, 5) Community & Economic Development, and 6) Water & Sanitation. Students came from the University of Texas at Arlington, UNT Forth Campus, and Tarrant County Community College. In addition, Rotaracts and individuals from the Goolsby Leadership Academy at UT Arlington were included in the process. The project took place in March, April, and May of 2014.

2. How many people benefited from this project? 7

3. Who were the beneficiaries, how were they impacted by this project, and what humanitarian need was met? Students came from the University of Texas at Arlington, UNT Forth Campus, and Tarrant County Community College. In addition, Rotaracts and individuals from the Goolsby Leadership Academy at UT Arlington were included in the process. The project took place in March, April, and May of 2014. The scholarships will enable the recipients the ability to complete their senior year or their first year of medical school. The financial assistance will enable these young individuals the opportunity to realize their dreams. In addition, in many instances their field of study will allow them to use what they learn to help people in the future. This is most evident for those entering the medical professions.


