A beautiful fire ring and two benches have been completed at the new picnic pavilion area. The construction was contracted out by the city of Homer to Polar North Construction. The benches and fire ring are made of precast concrete and the benches have been rock-faced. Our club had a work party to spread topsoil around the whole area in preparation for seeding along with putting a rock mixture around the fire pit area.
