This project is done in partnership with the City of Irvine’s 2-11 Marine Adoption Committee. The beneficiaries are Marine and their families from Camp Pendleton. The project fits into both the Area of Peace and Conflict Resolution in support of the peacemaker (Marines) and the Area of Maternal and Child Health (expectant mothers).

Projects would take place throughout the year: Holiday Party (December), Expectant Mothers Project (Spring); Marine Corps Ball (June) and Welcome Home (various times following return from deployment).
