Project Description

1. Describe the project. What was done, when, and where did project activities take place? If this is a progress report, what remains to be done?

Three neighborhoods merge at this garden space broken up into plots that families signed up to to plant, tend and harvest for personal use. Many families never having gardened before were new to all aspects. Rotarians entered the project in the fall, buying a roto-tiller, straw to cover the gardens as the families put each to rest for the winter, shelving for the tool shed and rose bushes to be planted in the Spring. Those benefitting were from low income families. Several were refugee families, having arrived to Anchorage very recently and others were single parent families.

They met with project leaders from the Anchorage Land Trust to peruse the space in fall and ascertain what needs were most urgent considering the gardens had just been harvested. They attend the garden's grand opening and they also plan to assist in planting rose bushes that were purchased and held over from the winter months.

The Anchorage Land Trust oversees the project and coordinates opportunities for more individuals to learn about seed planting and growing a garden. They also are planning an art project with area non-profits to bring public art to the fencing surrounding the garden to beautify the space when it is not in its height of natural full bloom.


