Purchase of Kitchen Equipment for the Veterans Association Building in Oceanside

3. Briefly describe the grant and list any changes that might have occurred (100 words or less)

The Veterans Association of North County is establishing the Veterans Memorial Building in Oceanside to serve the needs of more than 30 veterans organizations and the estimated 80,000 military veterans and their families in North San Diego County. The amenities in the new facility will include a full-service kitchen. Our grant was used to purchase a large reach-in freezer, one of the pieces of equipment requested by the VANC leadership. This and other equipment purchased by several organizations will be installed as soon as all acquisitions have been completed.

4. Provide a brief (100 words or less) of lessons learned in implementing this grant and how this will improve future grant funded projects:

Implementation of this grant has proved interesting. Working separately but in concert with other organizations—including another Rotary Club which had far more dollars to spend on this project than did our club, and whose project leadership wanted to run the whole show—was not easy. Ultimately, we worked alone and directly with the VANC officials to meet our club's grant commitment.

In our case, multiple organizations working on a common project made implementation of our grant more difficult. We will, in the future, seek grant opportunities that involve our club alone.


