Vocational Day gave members and other professionals a chance to share their knowledge with 133 students while giving seniors some job shadowing experience. We have a chance to introduce Rotary and the good we do, to the high school seniors and the community while helping shape future generations. Over 20 VPS's from the local community and the district participated.


