Project Description

1.Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?

For the 2nd year (would have been 3rd but for the pandemic), RYLA participants will work with the City of Stephenville, Texas, to further develop and improve the Collins Street Trailhead of the Bosque River Trail in Stephenville, Texas. This year's contribution to the City was applied to the purchase and installation of a refillable-water bottle station, which will be acknowledged as "donated to the City by the Stephenville Rotary Club" as part of an ongoing RYLA project.

At our regular Club meeting, April 22, 2021, we presented a bank check to Stephenville City Councilman Brandon Huckabee, for delivery to the City Secretary Staci King.

On May 4, 2021, Stephenville Rotary President Moumin Quazi, along with Immediate Past-President Rosemary Nagle and President-Elect Ron Henry, presented a ceremonial check for \$9000, recognizing our cumulative contribution to the City of Stephenville during its monthly City Council meeting (see photo). - 2. How many Rotarians participated in the project? The entire Club contributed its matching \$1500 to the District's \$1500. To collect that money, Stephenville Rotarians participated in our flag posting fundraiser, which involved 13 Club members who posted and picked up flags on major holidays, throughout the City. We also made an official presentation to the City, noted above, which involved three Rotarians.
