3. Briefly describe the grant and list any changes that might have occurred (100 words or less. This grant offered parents 7 sessions on improving overall health especially in the area of nutrition. Parents and some high school students participated in cooking classes with a focus on healthy foods and new vegetables they could introduce into their Hispanic diet as well as nutritious ways to prepare food such as steamers, woks and grills. Participants were educated by a certified nutritionist, a certified athletic/aerobics teacher and a counselor who helps adults and children with making healthy life-style choices.
4. Provide a brief (100 words or less) of lessons learned in implementing this grant and how this will improve future grant funded projects: I would have included the purchase of a cook book of healthy eating in Spanish and English. If we continue with these classes (and there is a huge interest in so doing) the students and teachers could benefit from the purchase of some cooking utensils and equipment for on-going cooking lessons. These would remain at the site. Also, care needs to be taken when scheduling any kind of class on the same day as Little League because in a small town, one event draws attendance from the other. This affected this grant on two days.
