Because of delays in getting permits, we have not been able to make the progress that we had hoped. We have been waiting for permits from the TCEQ (that we should have had 3 months ago) so we can have a place to dump the debris that is to be torn down and removed. We have already paid RECLAIMING STAMFORD \$2,900.00 for the portion of the work they have agreed to do When their work is completed, we can begin another phase of the project.
