- Briefly describe the project. What was done and where did the project activities take place?
   Explain how the beneficiaries and other community members were involved?
   The Campbell County Health Care Foundation, now known as the Northeast Wyoming Community Health Foundation organized the project for the innoculation of students from Campbell County School District, Gillette, Wyoming. In the school year of 2021-2022, 1908 students received the vaccines. 2216 students signed up for the shots, but for various reasons, only 86% of those students who signed up, actually appeared to get the innoculations. Two-hundred and seenty-seven (277) doses were returned to Campbell County Public Health Department. The Community Health Foundation is supported in this endeavor by Campbell County School District, Campbell County Memorial Hospital, The City and County of Gillette, Campbell County, Wyoming. The Center for Disease Prevention and Control recommends a yearly vaccination (flu) as the first step in protecting against flu and it's potentially serious complications.
   Because of COVID, the school district will no longer permit Rotarians to assist in the school's actual vaccination process.
- 2. How many Rotarians participated in this project? \_\_The entire membership of the Gillette Energy Rotary Club were involved in the decision to continue the VIP Project. assisting whenever or where ever possible.

  - a. Voted to continue the project
  - Conducted fund raising projects to support the vaccinations. Such as the annual Cajun Night Dinner and Show.

- 4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project? It is really difficult to determine exactly hiw many non-Rotarians will actually benefit from the use of the funds. When school children are vaccinated against influenza, their parents, siblings, other school children, staff, teachers and the community are less likely to contact the diesase and more safe from the effects of influenza.
