This grant allowed youth to attend courses at MCC at a reduced rate and gave Rotarians the opportunity to engage with youth. The grant eased the registration burden of the parent allowing youth to learn something new, have fun, and be created. Originally written to include t-shirts for the theatre camp, the instructor decided not to provide t-shirts, which allowed us to extend the grant into the fall/winter, serving 83 youth. Rotarians assisted at the theatre presentations as ushers, helped with art classes, and provided snacks to youth.

This grant served the youth population of the McCook area. As Rotarians, we learned that many of our youth population are underserved when it comes to extra-curricular education during the summer months. Many of the area youth partake in extra-curricular athletic camps and there are few courses offered in education in the field of art, stem, music, science, and theatre classes. While learning what is not offered to our area youth, we can see a need which Rotary can potentially fill in the future, by offering educational courses, strictly to the underserved population of youth in our area.
