1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?

In coordination with the Fountain Valley School District, the club purchased and distributed age appropriate hard bound library books for at risk students in grades 1-3 at seven school sites. More than forty new library books were purchased for each elementary school library. The books were high interest and were presented by a Rotarian at each school. Each book was marked on its inside cover with a permanent Rotary Certificate acknowledging the donor.

2. How many Rotarians participated in the project?

Eight to eleven club members participated in the distribution and presentation.

3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples.

One coordinating Rotarian and the school district superintendent, also a member of the Rotary Club organized the presentations with the school district's head librarian and scheduled the presenters.

4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project?

Approximately 2,100 1-3 grade students in the district benefitted from the project.

5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project?

Research shows that students' ability to read by the time they reach third grade provides a lifetime skill that is demonstrated through the student's school career and well into adulthood.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role?

The Fountain Valley School District worked closely with the Fountain Valley Rotary Club to organize, select and present the books.
