1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?
The project provided Thanksgiving meals to low income families. The care packages were assembled at the Boys and Girls Club of Laguna Beach the week of November 18th 2013 and distributed to the families on November 25th 2013. In addition, the club used the excess funds from the approved project to assist an additional 30 families with Easter care packages for low income families. Easter baskets were assembled at the Boys and Girls Club of Laguna Beach on April 8th 2014 and distributed on April 10th 2014. How many Rotarians participated in the project?

We had 30 Rotarians involved on 4 sub-committees in each care package disbursement.

3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples.

Sub-Committee #1 performed the shopping and pick-up of the food and boxes. Sub-Committee #2 assembled the non-perishable packages. Sub-Committee #3 inserted perishable food and handed out to the families. Sub-Committee #4 took pictures and sent out press releases to all local papers.

4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project?

113 families benefited, 83 families at Thanksgiving and 30 families at Easter.

5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project?

Provides hunger relief during tough economic times and raises the club's visibility in Laguna Beach and surrounding communities with civic and business leaders.
