Project Title: Service Above Self First Aid/Disaster Preparedness Project

Progress Report Final Report

1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?

Irvine Rotary collaborated with Orange County Fire Authority, MT SAC Paramedic Academy, Mayor of Irvine - Farrah Khan, UCI Rotaract, South County Outreach Food Bank and Rotary District 5320 to provide the "STOP THE BLEED" first aid and disaster training to student volunteers from all local high schools who are members of the Irvine High School Action Team. Students learned life saving emergency trauma techniques from Orange County Fire Authority and MT SAC paramedic academy to save lives in the event of a traumatic injury including bandaging, tourniquet use, etc. Students were educated about community service opportunities in Rotary.

The training was followed by the high school student volunteers assembling 100 first aid kits and disaster kits and notes of inspiration for kits to be delivered to local food shelter South County Outreach to be distributed to low income households in Orange County.

2. How many Rotarians participated in the project? 12 Rotarians 50 Non-Rotarians

3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples. Rotarians worked with Orange County Fire Authority to schedule and collaborate with numerous agencies to plan the project, educational elements and obtain feedback for the first aid kit/disaster preparedness kits. Rotarians also helped pre-prepare the supplies for the numerous high school students from all high schools in Irvine to assemble the first aid/disaster kit and words of inspiration.

4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project? 100-150 people

5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project? The "Stop the Bleed" program taught high school students life saving first aid kits that will last throughout their lives. Furthermore, the first aid and disaster kits distributed through South County Outreach to 100 low income residents will save lives for years to come in the event of a disaster.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role?

- Orange County Fire Authority – Provided the "Stop the Bleed" presentation and Disaster Preparedness Presentation
- MT SAC Paramedic Academy – Provided hands on first aid training to stop bleeding including training using bandaging techniques, tourniquets, compression techniques, etc.
- Mayor of Irvine Farrah Khan – Provided short presentation re: the importance of keeping families safe and supporting rescue efforts to high school students
- UCI Rotaract – Provided assistance at event to students with first aid training supporting MT SAC paramedic students
- Irvine Rotary – Planning, funding and Collaboration of project – Liaison with all other groups
- Rotary District 5320 – District Governor Nominee provided education about opportunities in Interact clubs for interested students.
- South County Outreach – Recipient of the first aid kits and providing distribution to low income households through its food pantry.
