Project Description

1. Describe the project. What was done, when, and where did project activities take place? If this is a progress report, what remains to be done?

The day (Street Outreach Advocacy Program) and overnight (Fairbanks Youth Advocates) shelters provide meals and beverages to homeless youth in Fairbanks, Alaska. We contributed food and beverages to these organizations in June 2013 and in January and February 2014. Hunter Elementary School serves disadvantaged students, some of whom are homeless and hungry. We provided nutritious snacks for the nurse and teachers to have available for these children.

 Homeless youth benefitted by having nutritious food both at the shelters and "to-go". During a particularly hot summer we provided beverages to keep the youth hydrated. Hungry school children were provided with healthy snacks.
