District and Pocatello Centennial Rotary \$5,000 funding paid part of stipend for a resident psychiatrist from University of Utah Health (about \$15,000 total) to assess and follow up with indigent people needing psychosocial medication and counseling at the Pocatello Free Clinic in Pocatello, Idaho between July 2023 and March 2024. See impact letter.
4. In one brief sentence: who were the beneficiaries of the grant activities and how many of them were there? Indigent residents without insurance, some food insecurity, some homeless. Served 62 initial assessments and 80 follow-up visits between July 2023 and March 2024. See impact letter and spreadsheet for details.
5. How many Rotarians participated in the project? About 25 Briefly tell what did. Rotarians raised matching funds, helped arrange additional \$10,000 funding to cover a full year of psychiatric resident support, arranged collaboration with groups needing services such as refugees and Native Americans, and assisted with community publicity for the project. Rotarian work will help the psychiatry project continue in the 2024-25 time frame.
