Project Description

1. Describe the project. What was done, when, and where did project activities take place? If this is a progress report, what remains to be done?

Anchorage Midtown Rotary Club has been awarding one or two \$500.00 scholarships to graduates each year from SAVE (Specialized Academic and Vocational Education) High School in Anchorage. For more than 25 years, this school has provided a proven alternative program for students who have difficulties in a large high-school setting. All students there combine academic work with a minimum of four hours of paid employment at certified businesses.

Anchorage Midtown Rotary Club wants to expand the number to four scholarship awards in 2014. The club believes these awards recognize and affirm worthy youth-at-risk by providing funds to help alleviate some of the financial pressures of advanced education or training. Recipients are nominated by SAVE teachers and staff based on their academic and vocational accomplishments. A representative of Anchorage Midtown Rotary will personally award the scholarship certificate and check at the graduation ceremonies in May 16, 2014.

This is a final (close-out) grant report.

2. How many people benefited from this project? Four Students

3. Who were the beneficiaries, how were they impacted by this project, and what humanitarian need was met?
SAVE High School Seniors were the beneficiaries of the grant. The scholarship motivated them to pursue higher education. The club believes these awards recognize and affirm worthy youth at risk by providing funds to help alleviate some of the financial pressures of advanced education or training. This meets Rotary area of focus for basic education and literacy.
