

Approximately a dozen Rotarians attended the lampshade auction to assist in supporting the event. One Rotarian coordinated all activities related to the effort and was involved in procuring the books that were purchased with the District Block Grant.

4. If a cooperating organization is involved, what is it's role?

Idaho Falls School District 91 coordinated purchase of books for the One District, One Book project – including the purchase from the District Block Grant. The City of Idaho Falls provided a \$1500 grant to cover the cost of lampshades and materials, marketing material development, printing and distribution, and ads. The Rotary Club provided funds to cover the cost of food and beverage for the auction night. The Art Museum of Eastern Idaho coordinated with area artists for converting the lampshades into works of art. The Idaho Falls Arts Council coordinated display space in the Willard Arts Center and hosted the auction night. High School students photographed the lampshades and developed a website associated with the event.



