The purpose of this project was to upgrade to the Pediatric Oncological Center of Tijuana to reduce or eliminate the need to transfer children cancer patients to other hospitals for test and treatment in Tijuana, Mexico. Upgrades included purchasing equipment for treatment rooms at the facility.

This grant directly involved the cooperative efforts of three District 5340 clubs; two out of district clubs in non-future Visions Districts.; the host club, Club Rotario Tijuana Milenio Minarete; and District 4100. These funds are in process of being used for additional supplies for the center to augment the equipment purchased.
