## Project Description

1. Describe the project. What was done, when, and where did project activities take place?

West High School Interact Club, under the umbrella of Anchorage East Rotary, held an international chocolate dessert tasting event in Anchorage in October 2014 to raise funds to provide education scholarships to students in Malawi. These Malawian students, many of whom are HIV/AIDS orphans, are actors in the theatre project of Together! ACT Now whose mission is to educate about the disease and prevent transmission. The Malawian students' participation in the educational theatre productions earned them credits towards educational scholarships administered by Together! Act Now in coordination with the Limbe Malawi Rotary Club. They also had to write an application explaining why they were the best suited recipients for the funds; a few examples have been included. Together! ACT Now is a registered 501(c)3 tax-deductible organization founded and directed by former West High student, Kyle Horne.
