Project Title: Backpacks for Kids P-507

Project Description

1. Describe the project. What was done, when, and where did project activities take place?

Backpacks, rotary pins and school supplies were purchased starting July 2014, assembled in August and distributed from the end of August up into October 2014 (latter date for when backpacks were distributed in Kodiak villages). Backpacks were pinned with the Rotary pin, a small fold-out describing Rotary, and then items such as pencils, crayons, glue sticks, erasers and notebooks were zipped inside each bag. Larger items that would be for the classroom (tissues and disinfectant wipes) were included to schools

2. How many people benefited from this project? 180

3. Who were the beneficiaries, how were they impacted by this project, and what humanitarian need was met?

Kids from Kindergarten through Fifth grade that had a need for school supplies received a backpack with school supplies included.

4. How many Rotarians participated in the project? 25

5. What did they do? Please give at least two examples, not including financial support provided to the project.

We utilized one Rotary meeting to stuff the backpacks with all the school supplies. A smaller amount of Rotarians distributed the backpacks to the local schools, and also to the Kodiak Island Borough School District Office so they could get the backpacks to each village (Old Harbor, Ouzinkie, Port Lions, Larsen Bay, Karluk, etc). 94 backpacks were distributed to city schools, and 74 to the village schools, and a dozen went to Salvation Army to also distribute.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role?

We distributed one dozen to the Salvation Army to give out to kids in need of school supplies (Salvation Army Jennifer and Michael Bates are active Rotary members also).


