Project Description

1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries? Richard J. Wilson Elementary is in a disadvantaged socio economic area of Fort Worth, Texas. 99.5% of its students are Hispanic. The dedicated Faculty of RJ Wilson and members of Rotary Club of Fort Worth South (RCFWS) felt that students would be motivated and assisted toward greater student achievement by use of modern computer technology which was out of budgetary reach of the school and parents. After discussing this idea with the Fort Worth ISD, it was discovered that iPads to facilitate instruction was planned for the future but no funding was in the budget, however, the ISD was willing to let the RCFWS implement this innovation at Richard J. Wilson as a pilot project.

2. How many Rotarians participated in the project? 20

3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples. Planned and facilitated the needs assessment and implemented identification of equipment required and purchasing of the equipment. Met with Fort Worth ISD IT personnel to facilitate implementation of the equipment. Delivered the iPad equipment.

Over a 5 year period a higher quality of education and higher academic achievement will be seen at Richard J. Wilson Elementary by advanced learning techniques exposure to an underprivileged segment of students.
