Adam's Camp Alaska is a new camp that provides intensive, multidisciplinary therapy program for children ages 4-12 years with developmental delays including, but not limited to: autism, cerebral palsy, and Down syndrome. Campers benefit from one-on-one therapy that is focused on an individualized goal-centered treatment plan through Alaska adventure activities (rock climbing, rafting, hiking, wildlife viewing and more. 
