Project Description

1. Describe the project. What was done, when, and where did project activities take place?

Malawi is one of, if not the, poorest country in Africa. Located between Zambia, Tanzania and Mozambique in southeast Africa, Malawi Children's Village (MVC) provides services for orphans and other vulnerable children in the Mangochi area. This project provided fifty double 'occupancy' student desks and a significant amount of basic school supplies such as paper, pens, flip charts and chalkboard items for the MCV schools.

3. Who were the beneficiaries, how were they impacted by this project, and what humanitarian need was met?
 MCV students. One of the main school classrooms had no desks and students either stood or sat on the floor. Now, with two students seated at each desk, the desks are used by 100 students at a time. As students move through the classroom, a total of 300 students make use of them. And the school supplies are being used through-out the MCV schools. This project enabled and strengthened the capacity of MCV to support basic education and literacy of Malawi orphans and other vulnerable children/young people.


