
We had other organizations that wanted to participate in the amazing program. They set up booths and talked with parents and children. See attached list of booth

Presented by the Rotary Club of Peoria, the event features all kinds of water activities, booths, demonstrations by firefighters with Peoria Fire Department, a chance to meet Josh the Otter and just plain fun in the pool.

Books featuring Josh the Otter will be given away to all children who attend.

The event is intended to bring awareness to childhood drowning. In 2013, the child deaths in pools occurred in warm and cold months. The Maricopa drowning death rate for children 0 to 4 years of age in 2013 was 4.4 deaths per 100,000 children (in all bodies of water). It has been slowly increasing since 2006. The rate of deaths in swimming pools rose similarly, but non-pool related deaths have been decreasing.

An emphasis on issues relating to supervision of children will have the greatest impact on nonfatal incidents, especially in the summer time. Community campaigns are needed to address the incidents occurring in home pools in the summer time.

So, don those swim trunks and bathing suits, grab your little ones, and bring them to an event that could save their lives.

2015 Event Site Map



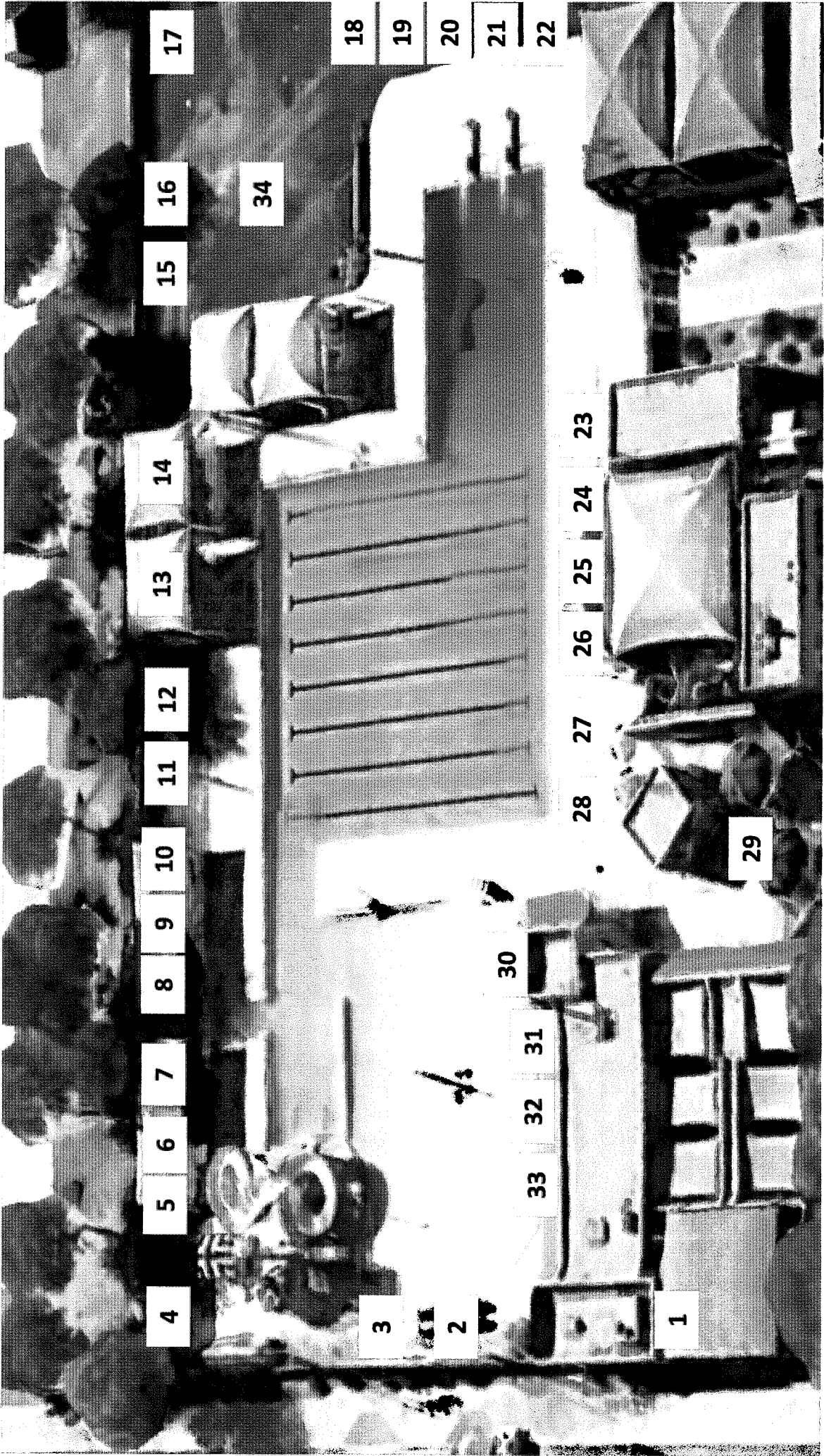

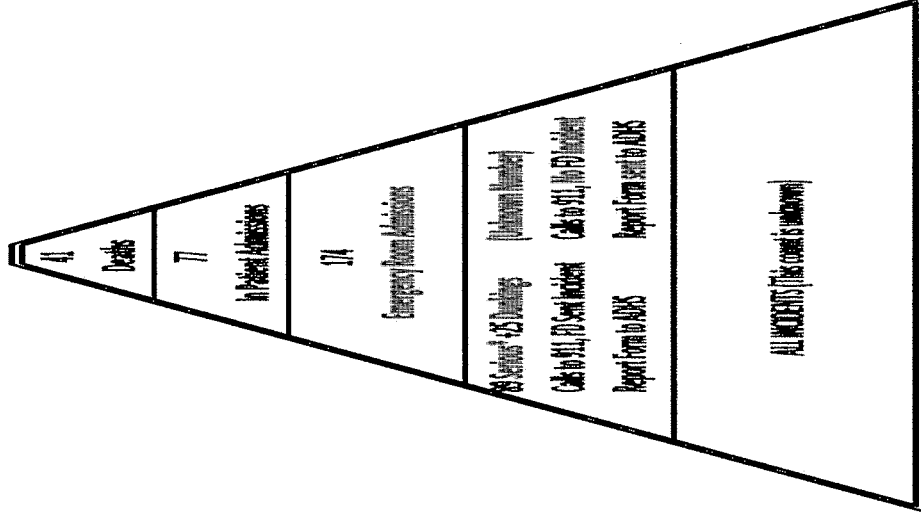

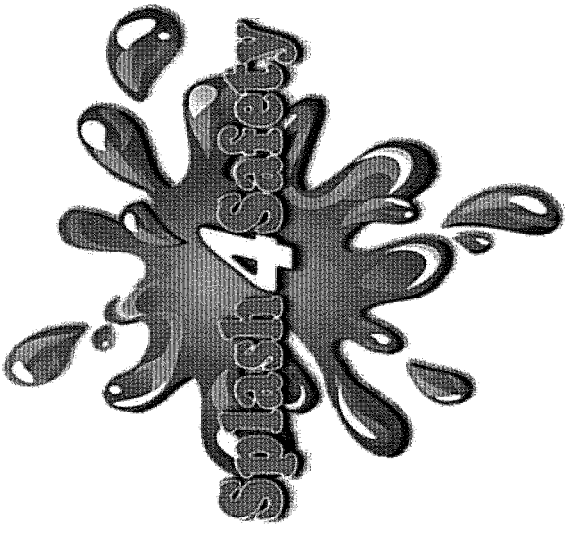

Did you know...

- Drowning is the number one cause of unintentional injury death in the United States for children aged 1-4.
- For children aged 1-4, drowning claims the lives of more young children each year than unintentional motor vehicle accidents, poisoning, fire arms and falls combined.
- For every child 1-4 years old who dies from drowning, another eight receive emergency department care for nonfatal submersion injuries, many of which result in life-long disabilities due to brain damage from lack of oxygen.
- Drowning is the third leading cause of unintentional injury death worldwide.

In 2013, child deaths in pools occurred in both warm and cold months. The Maricopa drowning death rate for children 0-4 years of age in 2013 rose to 4.4 deaths per 100,000 children (in all bodies of water), and has been slowly increasing since 2006. The rate of deaths in swimming pools rose similarly, but non-pool related deaths have been decreasing.
