Any frozen goods that were donated had to be stored in freezers of area volunteers, creating a lot of paperwork for the volunteer staff and extra running around for clients. The room they Food Pantry uses did not have any electrical outlets, so we had to have the room wired for electricity. The remaining funds were used to fill the freezer with food from the local grocery store.
