This grant funded the transportation and training of 3 Hispanic women in the Latino Family Literacy Project and the purchase of necessary materials. This project trains adults to work specifically with Hispanic families to promote a pride in heritage and a focus on the importance of literacy in families' lives. The adults then received a stipend for supplying organization of materials and training in their communities — especially our isolated and rural community of Ocotillo Wells.

One change was the addition of an additional adult to organize and catalog a large amount of books that were donated to the OW Literacy Center as a result of the positive publicity around this Rotary Project.

The grant and the implementation were extremely well received by the folks involved. The only suggestions I have are included in the question # 6 below.
