Recognizing the change needed to fund future scholarship programs, it decided to fund one Scholar as a transition from the old method to the new method. Our Scholar was fortunate enough to be placed in Rhodes University, Grahamstown, South Africa. With this being a southern hemisphere university placement, this required us to fund the program over two Rotary years; 2013-14 and 2014-15. Our District intended to fund \$27,000 total for the scholarship award.
