1. Describe your project. What was done, when and where did the project activities take place. If this is a progress report, what remains to be done?

The project was to provide low cost ski racing training to local children in the Wood River Valley. The ski school was held at Rotarun Ski Area during the short ski season of winter 2015.

2. Who were the beneficiaries, how were they impacted, how many were impacted by this project and what humanitarian needs were met?

The beneficiaries were 51 school age children that received not only training for ski racing but also information on nutrition and healthy lifestyles. This project met the need for affordable skiing and ski racing training for school age children that would not be able participate in this type of activity otherwise. The opportunity for supervised winter outdoor activity and education met a need for healthy activities and an introduction to life time opportunities.

No Rotarians were directly involved in running the ski school. However, there are three members of the Hailey Rotary club that sit on the Board of the Rotarun Ski Area. Several members of the Hailey Rotary Club have volunteered at work days at the area in the last year. One of the projects involved building snow fencing to replace the fencing that was burned in the 2014 Beaver Creek Fire.

The Rotarun Ski Area was involved in operating the ski area and running the ski school.
