Briefly describe the grant and list any changes that might have occurred (100 words or less. **The initial grant was to purchase dictionaries for 3<sup>rd</sup> graders in the Santee and Lakeside school districts. The teachers requested that we purchase an iPad app – Nearpod since third graders were issued iPads as their primary source of information. We complied since they indicated students were accessing dictionaries online. Nearpod still supports Literacy but provides a different modality for accessing information – it is the literacy of tomorrow. Licenses were purchased for each teacher’s classroom and are valid through June 2016. The club felt this was important enough that they added additional dollars to make this happen.**
4. Provide a brief (100 words or less) of lessons learned in implementing this grant and how this will improve future grant funded projects: **We should have had this conversation with school administrators before submitting the grant request. This would have allowed us to submit the grant with the current project described. We did talk to Marilyn Sanderson about whether this would change the grant in any way. She felt that it still supported literacy so we moved ahead.**



