We traveled to the school in September of this year to pay a number of the bills directly to utilities for the school. We also purchased food at Costco in Mexico for the staff and returning students, as well as classroom supplies. We will be making another trip down in January for our annual Christmas Party in January for the children. All funding for this activity comes out of club funds and member donations and is not part of the District Grant monies received. Our club participation is 100% in this project. All receipts are attached.

RSM is the only free school for deaf children in Mexico. Not only do many children learn how to communicate for the first time when they come to school, they also learn basic education and trade skills to allow them to earn a living when they graduate from the school's program.
