We want to honor students who:

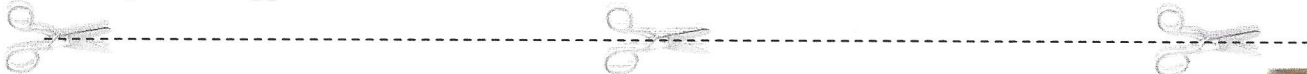
- participated two or more years in their Interact Club and/or

- have strong academic achievement and/or
- live by the 4-Way Test (those who are truthful, fair, build goodwill/friendships, and benefit others).

TO APPLY FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP

Fill out the information below, including the names of at least 2 current staff members to serve as references for you, and attach a copy of your transcripts.

Turn in the completed application to your Interact Advisor or your Rotary Advisor by Tuesday, April 7th.

A Screening Committee will evaluate the applications and choose the winners of the scholarship. The number of Kindle Fires awarded will depend on the available funds and upon the number of qualified applicants.
