Provision of food to the Yorba Linda Food for Families. Other organizations also contribute to the food bank. This is usually groups such as churches and similarly minded people wishing to assist others.

15 Rotarians from the club assisted with transport of food and distribution to families weekly.

Food was purchased from Second Harvest and then transported by Rotarians to the Food Bank. Additionally food items and gift cards for families were purchased from places like Stater Brothers. Rotarians then packed food packages based on family needs every week and dispensed packages to families, check on family progress and generally give them support in their endeavors.

- More than 250 people benefitted from this support. Around 50 families comprising 4 to 5 persons per family.
- 5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project?

Long term benefits are significant. Most importantly the children are properly fed, which has positive impact on their growth and their mental well being. Additionally, it provides parents with needed support whilst they work through tough times. And helps them get back on their feet.

Second Harvest Food Banks allows us to purchase food at significantly reduced rates. This means that the doallrs from the grant and the club go a great deal further, ie support more people better.
