Regarding how many people benefited from the Rotary Club of College AK partnership with Stone Soup Café to build and plant a garden in the summer of 2015:

It is hard to say exactly how many people benefited.

The café serves meals to 100 people per day, 5 days per week.

The harvest began June 8th, 2015

The last harvest was September 20th, 2015

The storage of some vegetables, such as potatoes, meant that garden food was still being served until January, 2016.

500 pounds of produce was harvest by Stone Soup. Additionally, some community members in need were seen to occasionally pick vegetables to feed their family on their own.

Basic math might suggest 24 weeks of produce being served to 500 people per week = 12,000 people, but we know some of those people are eating there repeatedly so it is hard to quantify the number. If the exact same people came every day, which is certainly not the case, it would have benefitted at least 100 people.

A fair statement would be that several hundred people enjoyed thousands of meals with fresh vegetables because of this garden.
