Project Description

1. Describe the project. What was done, when, and where did project activities take place? If this is a progress report, what remains to be done?

The McCook Skatepark, now called Bolles Canyon Skatepark, was completed by the City of McCook in the September of 2015. Both phases of the project were fully funded.

2. How many people benefited from this project?

Hundreds of youth and young adults. 15 to 25 users on any given nice day. Estimated 300 unique users to date.

3. Who were the beneficiaries, how were they impacted by this project, and what humanitarian need was met?

The skatepark serves all youth, but specially non-traditional athletes that tend to be under served. Ages typically range from 5 years to 35, both male an female.

4. How many Rotarians participated in the project? At least four helped directly.

5. What did they do? Please give at least two examples, not including financial support provided to the project.

Planning, organizing meetings, communicating with stakeholders, locating potential sites, assisting the skatepark organization in the work of fundraising.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role? The organization "Build McCook a Skatepark" was the lead organization. Rotarian Rex Nelson chaired that organization. That was the platform for organizing youth and young adults to work through the entire project development and execution. The City of McCook provided the site, and actually contracted the construction of the facility. No construction funds were handled by McCook Rotary or by Build McCook a Skatepark.
