The picnic tables offer an area for families to eat while enjoying the park. During the winter, youth and adults use it for hockey and for the first time this year, an outdoor movie will be shown. The Kenai River – Soldotna club plans to provide a visible presence during the movie and to continue with our regularly scheduled site cleanups.
