Project Title: Rotary Play Park – Phase I

Project Description

1. Describe the project. What was done, when, and where did project activities take place?

Rotary Club of Fairbanks is constructing a play park with additional (much needed) parking, several pavilions for picnicking and gatherings, and individual play nodes (or areas) for all ages along a handicapped accessible walking path on a natural peninsula across from the swim beach in the Tanana Lake Recreation Area along the Tanana River in Fairbanks. The peninsula has been cleared of garbage and debris with the parking area cleared for the gravel pad to be spread as soon as the weather permits.

The residents of the Fairbanks North Star Borough benefit from this project with a new play park for all ages in the Tanana Lakes Recreation Area across from the swim beach with additional parking and facilities.

The Fairbanks North Star Borough owns the area and has been instrumental in obtaining the permits to allow the park to be constructed.
