Project Title: P-825 Playground Equipment Safety Material

Project Description

1. Describe the project. What was done, when, and where did project activities take place?

The project is located at South Davis Park in Fairbanks. The safety material consists of ADA compliant foam pads, which is then covered by ForeverLawn (similar to astro turf). The site prep is now complete, playground equipment bases installed, and the foam pads and ForeverLawn material installed, making the 4500 sq. ft. handicap accessible by those who are confined to wheelchairs.

3. Who were the beneficiaries, how were they impacted by this project, and what humanitarian need was met?

The beneficiaries are children who are disabled, confined to wheel chairs, or their parents who may be confined to wheelchairs. The playground, however, is available to any children, with or without disabilities.

4. How many Rotarians participated in the project? 28+

5. What did they do? Please give at least two examples, not including financial support provided to the project.

Rotarians were involved in assisting with site preparation for installation, and with assisting the installers. In addition, Rotarians participated in the raking, grass seeding, fertilizing and rolling about 5,000 Sq. Ft. so that the grounds around the playground area will not erode over time. Rotarians were involved in assembling the playground equipment after installation of the Forever Lawn.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role? Several partners played key roles in this project. Johnson River Enterprises provided much in-kind donation of equipment, labor and materials toward preparation of the grounds, using heavy equipment to contour the site for proper water run off, directing installation of the timbers, spreading crushed rock on the foot path and base material beneath the foam and ForeverLawn. Others who helped were the Alaska Center for Children and Adults who applied on the club's behalf for a Tier 1 Rasmuson grant. Carlisle Transport and TOTE Maritime arranged for shipping of materials at no cost to the club. ForeverLawn provided \$10,000 in-kind donation toward total materials.
