Report from the Mat Su Food Bank:

The grant was used to purchase and install the holding racks in both vans. These racks allow us to stack meals that are stored in acrylic cold storage pans, stainless hotel pans, or milk crates. The racks prevent the pans from sliding or slipping out of the ends. We are able to double up on each rack with no issues whatsoever giving us the ability to store 12 pans per trip. The racks make our deliveries faster, easier, and much more professional.

The grant was also used towards the wrap installed on the gray van. It is colorful, informative, and definitely promotes our free meals for children.
