In addition to the house, our funds also purchased and installed a sanitary toilette. The receiving family is a family of 5, consisting of 3 girls and the parents. RB Sunrise members and others participated in the construction of the house. Pictures are shown of the project; the participants, including the family; and the family.

RB Sunrise intends to build a second house in March (or April, depending on rains).
