Project Description

1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?

The Rotary Club of Anthem awarded five \$1,000 scholarships to outstanding college-bound high school seniors living in the Anthem, Arizona area. The District 5490 \$390 Scholarship Augmentation Grant—to match \$130 of the club-funded scholarships—effectively increased those awards \$39 per student per semester during the 2015-16 academic year. This helped ease the financial burden of the students and their families.

Rotary Foundation Committee Chair Rick Nollenberger wrote the grant application, managed the implementation, informed the recipients of the award, wrote the media release to regional media and prepared the final report. Club Treasurer Tom Leyda maintain strict documentation for- and control of grant funds and the disbursement thereof.

5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project?

The grant augmented scholarships increased the students' opportunity to succeed academically and enhance the quality of life when they return to their communities. Informing the public of the awards creates greater awareness of RI support of education and encourages more students to seek higher education through Rotary scholarship assistance.

Student Financial Services staffs at the students' respective universities provided the verifications of enrollment that are key to implementing and disbursing the scholarships.


