Project Description

1. Describe the project. What was done, when, and where did project activities take place?
 Provide two Kids Don't Float ('KDF') cabinets for loaner life jackets at Alaska State Parks in Kodiak; one at Lake Gertude in Fort Abercrombie State Park, and one at Buskin Beach State Park. Because of Kodiak conditions these were built using aluminum.

3. Who were the beneficiaries, how were they impacted by this project, and what humanitarian need was met?
 People who enter water deliberately or accidentally at Lake Gertude and Buskin Beach in Kodiak will have loaner life jackets available. Of equal or more importance is the KDF cabinet's signage and accompanying safety programs instill water safety caution and emergency reaction planning. This Kodiak project resulted from the 2014 drowning in Lake Gertude of a Kodiak High School student. As much as the available life preservers themselves increase safety, they segue to water recreationists planning and reaction for potential drownings.
