Everyday Leadership enabled 64 low-income to attend a three-day leadership camp at Horse thief Reservoir from May 19th to 21th. The Treasure Valley YMCA provided camp leaders. School Teacher Liaisons and Rotarians assisted. The camp was highly successful in reinforcing leadership skills, and providing the youth with sense of belonging, achievement and friendship. Nick Vice, a sixth grader, reported to his teacher, "Mrs. Rush, this camp is so amazing." Jeff Cullen, a Boise Sunrise volunteer, reported "I love doing this! It gives me the opportunity to invest in these kids who will be our future one day."
- 4. In one brief sentence: who were the beneficiaries of the grant activities and how many of them were there? Sixty-four low-income fifth and sixth grade students attending three Title I Schools.
