The Payette Lakes Community Association (PLCA) is a non-profit organization which provides after school programs for kids. The program is important because it provides a place for kids to go after school while their parents are still at work. Part-time teachers oversee the program. The PLCA provided a healthy snack and instructional activities focused on science, engineering and math skills. The kids took part in the following activities: building birdhouses, making and using a compass, building on science principles with Legos and Minecraft, building rockets and Physics in Motion. The PLCA program is offered at the Barbara Morgan Elementary School.

Approximately 25 to 30 kids from Grades 1st through 5th grade participated in activities after school Monday through Friday from 3 to 5:30 PM.
