3,853 books titled "The One and Only Ivan" were distributed to each family in Idaho Falls School District 91. These 3,853 books were purchased at a cost of \$16,375.25. The Idaho Falls Rotary fundraising efforts which include the Rotary District Grant, The Idaho National Laboratories Grant and the Lighting the Way to Literacy Event (Artist designed lampshades to be auctioned) raised a total of \$8,066. The remaining \$8,309.25 of the \$16,375.25 was raised by Idaho Falls School District 91 via contributions from School District 91 families, PTO's, patrons, individuals and sponsors. The Book was selected in November, purchased in the beginning of January, books were received by families in February.

- 4. In one brief sentence: who were the beneficiaries of the grant activities and how many of them were there? The 3,853 families with at least one child in Idaho Falls School District 91's Elementary Schools.

How many Rotarians participated in the project? 47 Briefly tell what they did. 10 Rotarians were very involved with the promotion and implementation of this event with 5 Rotarians on the planning committee which started working together as early as April 2015. This planning committee volunteered a total of 50+hours. There were over 50 people in attendance at the Lighting the Way to Literacy Event, 74% were Rotarians. In addition, the Idaho Falls Rotary Interact Club with over 10 students promoted the event in the community.

The Eastern Idaho Art Museum and the Idaho Falls Arts Council brought the artists together to join this event and support it while dedicating 4 members on the planning committee 7.
