FIELD TRIP HIGHLIGHTS

- Program is based on CA Common Core State Standards and Next Generation Science Standards. Activities are grade specific.
- 4 hour (9am-1pm) program features 2 activity stations:
 - **Station #1:** Pontoon boat-based, on-the-water educational activity cruising around scenic Newport Bay
 - **Station #2:** Classroom/dock-based, hands-on activity focusing on a variety of marine-based subjects supporting STEM, Life and Physical Science, Language Arts, Math, Investigation, and History skills
- Activity Highlights (vary per grade):
 - Design, Build & Race Mini Catamaran Boats
 - Underwater Camera & Microscope Investigation
 - City Pollution & Water Filter Discovery
 - Harbor Excursion & Sea/Bird Life Exploration
 - Shark Dissection & Shark Fishing
 - Touch Tank Discovery – Sharks, sea slugs and more!
- \$15/student; teachers/chaperones are FREE!
- Limit 80 students per day; book additional days for more students
- Groups bring lunch (non-perishable); eat on NSB lawn
