The Anaheim Hills Rotary Club is pleased to announce that we will again be providing funding for programs at your schools under the auspices of our Aid for Educational Supplies Project. This is the second year of this project. Last year we provided funding for ten projects that otherwise might not have been funded.

Our Board has approved funding for the project. In addition, we have been able to secure a matching grant from Rotary International and District #5320.

Following is a brief outline of the project details, the application process, and the timeline associated with the project.

Our project is called <u>Aid for Educational Supplies</u>. The objective of the project is to provide funding for programs where funding is currently not available. We want to encourage our educational professionals and support their efforts with this project. We hope this funding will help your teachers undertake enrichment programs that they might not have been able to do without this financial assistance. The maximum award is \$500 per program. However, if one of your faculty has a "knock them out of the ball park idea" we should at least discuss the idea. Maybe we can find funding either now or at a later date.

Attached is the Application for Funding. We have tried to keep it straightforward. If any of your faculty has any questions, they should contact the Rotarian responsible for your school. The contact names will be sent under separate correspondence.

There is one important difference between this project and other Rotary projects that you might have previously participated in. One of the conditions of the matching grant that we received is that we (AHRC) must purchase the supplies/materials for each winning program. We have tried to streamline this project to minimize the effort on the part of your faculty. We will assign one AHRC member to each school and they will serve as the liaison with your faculty member for all aspects of the project. The timeline is:

Applications due by Friday, 06 February 2015
Judging of Applications completed by Tuesday, 17 February 2015
Awarding of Program Funding immediately following judging of the applications.
Target date for completion of the program 31 March 2015.

We look forward to working with you on this project.
